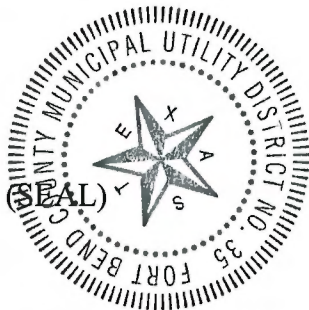
The meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 1, 2021, at 1:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and/or act on the following matters:

1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the August 4, 2021, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Review activity reports and/or receive updates regarding Fort Bend County Precinct 3 Constable's Office ("FBCCO");
4. Status of conversion to LED bulbs and painting of the decorative light poles in the community by CenterPoint Energy;
5. Status of installation of warning signs around bodies of water within the District;
6. Approval of Letter Agreement between the District and Seven Meadows Community Association, Inc. regarding proposal for wildflower seeding of certain recreational sites within the District;
7. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2021 tax rate;
8. Levy of the District's 2021 debt service and maintenance tax rates, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
9. Approval and execution of an Amended District Information Form;
10. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
11. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney Report, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;

14. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial investment reports, authorizing the payment of invoices presented;

 - a. Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District and acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - b. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, including:
 - (i) Repair of approximate 300-foot portion of Little Prong Creek at Fry Road utilizing the SOX erosion repair system and repair of outfall (Double Oak Erosion);
 - c. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
 - d. Consider installation of an emergency generator at the District's remote water well;
 - e. Status of waste discharge permit renewal applications for Wastewater Treatment Plant No. 1; and
 - f. Proposal for repair and/or rehabilitation of detention pond located at the southwest corner of Gaston Road and Fry Road;
16. Report by Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc., regarding maintenance of drainage facilities;
17. Storm Water Management Program for the District;
18. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - a. Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
